About Intervention

About Intervention The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested persons may intervene. An interested person may be granted intervention if the outcome of the case will di-rectly and substantially im-pact the person, and the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the is-sues in the case. Interven-tion, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to crossexamine other and to crossexamine other parties' witnesses. Interven-tion is not required if you want to appear at the hear-ing and provide public com-ment on the Application, or if you want to file written comments in the record of the case.

To request intervention, you must file an original and 13 hard copies of a written re-guest to intervene with Docket Control, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, no later than March 22,2017. You also must serve a copy of the request to intervene to intervene

On each party of record on the same day that you, file the request to intervene with the

Commission. Information about what intervention means, including an explan-ation of the rights and re-sponsibilities of an intervenor, is available on the

If you choose to request in-tervention, your request must contain the following: Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and tele-phone number of any per-son upon whom service of documents is to be made, if

not yourself; 2. A reference to Docket No. RR-03639A-17-0020; 3. A short statement ex-

plaining:

a. Your interest in the pro-ceeding (e.g., a customer of the Railroad, a neighboring property owner, a crossing user, etc.),

b. How you will be directly and substantially affected by the outcome of the case, and

c. Why your intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case:

A statement certifying that you have served a copy of the request to intervene on

The-Railroad or its attorney and all other parties of re-cord in the case; and

5. If you are not represent-ed by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona

State Bar and you are not representing yourself as an individual, sufficient

Information and any appropriate documentation to demonstrate compliance with

Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before March 22, 2017. ADA/Equal Access Informa-
