Re: EMERGENCY RATE CASE APPLICATION (Docket No. W-01559A-17-0074)

Coldwater Canyon Water Company is formally requesting an emergency surcharge to be effective immediately. The surcharge is necessary to ensure continued safe and adequate water service to our 216 customers. The Company's 30,000 gallon storage tank is leaking and needs to be repaired (see the provided pictures). Because this is the Company's only storage tank currently in production it is not possible to take the tank offline to effect the necessary repairs. Therefore the Company will need to hire a commercial diving crew to repair the leak from the inside of the tank while the tank still has water in it. The Company's research determined that at present there aren't any vendors in Arizona with the expertise to make this type of repair. However, the Company identified Midco Diving & Marine Services Inc. out of Colorado, who is qualified to make underwater repairs and contacted them for a quote.


On March 1st, 2017, Midco provided the Company with a quote (see Attachment 2). In discussing the scope of work with Midco the Company was informed that the existing manhole on top of the tank is too small per federal standards. Therefore, Midco will first have to cut out a properly sized hole and install a larger manhole at a cost of \$1,097.40. The cost for removal, installation and coating repair is \$1,478.00. The cleaning and inspection of the tank (including a DVD and written report) is \$2,699.00. In addition, Midco will charge the Company \$400 per hour for an estimated 2 days. The Company calculates that at 16 hours the total cost would be \$11,674.40 and at 24 hours the total cost would be \$14,874.40. Because there is uncertainty in the final price at the time of this request the Company proposes that the actual surcharge be determined once the work is complete.

The Company proposes to collect the emergency surcharge on a per month basis over 12 months. The Company currently has 204 customers with 5/8 X 3/4 inch meters, 9 customers with 1 inch meters, 1 customer with an inch and a half meter, and 2 customers with 2 inch meters, and as such we propose that a multiplier be used to set the surcharge for the larger meter sizes. The Company proposes that the surcharge stop as soon as soon as the full cost has been collected and any over collections be refunded to customers at a prorated amount as a reduction in the next regular bill as soon as the full amount has been recovered. With the uncertainty in the final price the Company offers the following per month per customer surcharge proposals at 16 hours, 20 hours and 24 hours of work:

PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION OF COLDWATER CANYON WATER COMPANY FOR AN EMERGENCY RATE INCREASE (DOCKET NO. W-01559A-17-0074)

On March 27, 2017, Coldwater Canyon Water Company ("Coldwater Canyon" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an emergency rate increase. The 30,000 gallon storage tank is leaking and needs to be repaired. The Company estimates that it will require up to \$14,874.40 to repair the tank and alleviate the emergency condition. The Company is requesting authorization to recover this amount in emergency rates by implementing a surcharge in the amount of up to \$5.36 per month for 12 months to be finalized upon completion of the repair.

The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") is in the process of reviewing and analyzing the Application. Neither Staff nor any intervenor(s) has yet made any recommendation regarding the Company's request. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenor(s), and the Commission may approve the amount of the request, modify the amount higher or lower, or deny the request.

Arizona Corporation Commission Public Hearing Information

The Commission will hold a full public hearing on this matter. The Commission's Hearing Division will schedule a procedural conference to occur within five business days of the filing of the Application in order to set a public hearing date and establish other procedural requirements.

The Company will provide notice of the hearing date by means of posting notice in a conspicuous location within the affected communities, emailing notice to customers, and/or posting on the Company's website (or by other appropriate means), to allow an opportunity for customers to attend the hearing and provide verbal public comment.

Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted at any time by mailing a letter referencing **Docket No. W-01559A-17-0074** to Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, or by submitting comments on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "Submit a Public Comment for a Utility" function. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section during regular business hours at 602-542-4251 or 1-800-222-7000.

About Intervention

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested persons may intervene. An interested person may be granted intervention if the outcome of the case will directly and substantially impact the person, and the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case. Intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other parties' witnesses. Intervention is not required if you want to appear at the hearing and provide public comment on the Application, or if you want to file

written comments in the record of the case.

To request intervention, you must file an original plus one hard copy of a written request to intervene with Docket Control, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, no later than April 7, 2017. You also must serve a copy of the request to intervene on each party of record on the same day that you file the request to intervene with the Commission. Information about what intervention means, including an explanation of the rights and responsibilities of an intervenor, is available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "Intervention in Utility Cases" link. The link also includes sample intervention requests.

If you choose to request intervention, your request must contain the following:

- 1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
- 2. A reference to **Docket No. W-01559A-17-0074**;
- 3. A short statement explaining:
 - a. Your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.);
 - b. How you will be directly and substantially affected by the outcome of the case; and
 - c. Why your intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case;
- 4. A statement certifying that you have served a copy of the request to intervene on the Company or its attorney and to all parties of record in the case; and
- 5. If you are not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and you are not representing yourself as an individual, sufficient information and any appropriate documentation to demonstrate compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that **all motions** to intervene must be filed on or before <u>April 7, 2017</u>.

If you do not intervene in this proceeding, you may not receive any further notice of the proceedings in this docket. However, all documents filed in this docket are available online (usually within 24 hours after docketing) at the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function. You may choose to subscribe to an RSS feed for this case using the e-Docket function.
