PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 15, 2017, the Utilities Division (“Staff”) of the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) filed a request to open this docket to process the forthcoming emergency rate application of Coldwater Canyon Water Company (“Coldwater Canyon” or “Company”).

On March 27, 2017, the Company filed its emergency rate application requesting the implementation of an emergency surcharge to cover the costs of repairing leaks in its only water storage tank. According to the Company, the surcharge is necessary to ensure the continued safe and adequate water service to its 216 customers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** for the purpose of discussing the procedural schedule shall commence on **April 6, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission’s offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall refer to the **Procedural Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **March 29, 2016**, for additional information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to Email Service is also available on the Commission’s website (www.azcc.gov) through the “Email Service Consent” link.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission’s Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


