8	APPROVAL OF AN EMERGENCY RATE INCREASE. PROCEDURAL ORDER	
9	BY THE COMMISSION:	
10	On March 15, 2017, the Utilities Division ("Staff") of the Arizona Corporation Commission	
11	("Commission") filed a request to open this docket to process the forthcoming emergency rate	
12	application of Coldwater Canyon Water Company ("Coldwater Canyon" or "Company").	
13	On March 27, 2017, the Company filed its emergency rate application requesting the	
14	implementation of an emergency surcharge to cover the costs of repairing leaks in its only water storage	
15	tank. According to the Company, the surcharge is necessary to ensure the continued safe and adequate	
16	water service to its 216 customers.	
17	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a procedural conference for the purpose of discussing	
18	the procedural schedule shall commence on April 6, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as is	
19	practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix,	
20	Arizona 85007.	
21	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall refer to the Procedural	
22	Order Regarding Consent to Email Service issued in this matter on March 29, 2016, for additional	
23	information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to

25	Service Consent" link.	
26	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules	
27	31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission pro hac vice.
