PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On March 15, 2017, Accipiter Communications Incorporated dba Zona Communications (“Accipiter” or “Company”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application to extend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”).

On March 23, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued regarding consent to email service.

On April 4, 2017, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (“CenturyLink”) filed an Application for Leave to Intervene as a Party and Motion for Joinder in Accipiter’s Application for Extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.

No objection has been filed to CenturyLink’s Application for Leave to Intervene or its Motion for Joinder in Accipiter’s Application for an Extension of its CC&N.

Accordingly, CenturyLink’s request for intervention and joinder in this matter should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC is hereby granted intervention in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC’s Motion for Joinder in this above-captioned application is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall refer to the **Procedural Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **March 23, 2017**, for additional


1 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules  
5 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
7 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision  
8 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or  
10 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
11 hearing.
