PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 12, 2017, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (“TracFone”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) to expand its eligible telecommunications carrier designation in the State of Arizona to include Tribal Lands.

On January 19, 2017, the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association (“ALECA”) filed a Motion to Intervene.

On January 20, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued regarding consent to email service.

On January 31, 2017, TracFone filed a Consent to Email Service.

On February 1, 2017, by Procedural Order, ALECA was granted intervention.

On February 3, 2017, Gila River Telecommunications, Inc. (“GRTI”) filed an Application to Intervene.

On February 8, 2017, by Procedural Order, TracFone’s Consent to Email Service was approved.

On February 13, 2017, by Procedural Order, GRTI was granted Intervention in this matter.

On February 17, 2017, GRTI filed a Consent to Email Service, however the Hearing Division has yet to receive its confirming email.

On March 27, 2017, Smith Bagley, Inc., d/b/a Cellular One of North East Arizona (“SBI”) filed an Application to Intervene.

On April 6, 2017, ALECA filed a Consent to Email Service.

1 On April 11, 2017, SBI was granted Intervention in this matter.

2 Also on April 11, 2017, GRTI and ALECA's Consents to Email Service were approved.

3 Again on April 11, 2017, Timothy Berg of Fennemore Craig, P.C. filed a Notice of Appearance,
4 Request to be Added to Service List on behalf of TracFone.

5 On April 17, 2017, SBI filed a Consent to Email Service.

6 On April 19, 2017, by Procedural Order, SBI's Consent to Email Service was approved.

7 On April 25, 2017, Greenberg Traurig, LLP filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Counsel for
8 TracFone Wireless, Inc. The Notice advised that Jennifer Cummins Rethemeier was no longer
9 employed by Greenberg Traurig and that TracFone had employed other counsel to represent it in this
10 matter.

11 On May 1, 2017, TracFone filed a Consent to Email Service.

12 On May 2, 2017, by Procedural Order, TracFone's Consent to Email Service was approved.

13 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jennifer Cummins Rethemeier and Greenberg Traurig,
14 LLP are hereby granted withdrawal as counsel for TracFone Wireless, Inc., and shall be taken off of
15 the service list.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall **refer to the Procedural**
17 **Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **January 20, 2017**, for additional
18 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to
19 Email Service is also available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) by clicking on "Email
20 Service Consent."

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules
22 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
24 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
25 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
27 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona
28 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all hearings

1 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for
2 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
3 Law Judge or the Commission.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
5 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
6 hearing.

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
