PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 15, 2017, the Utilities Division (“Staff”) of the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) filed a request to open this docket to process the forthcoming emergency rate application of Coldwater Canyon Water Company (“Coldwater Canyon” or “Company”).

On March 27, 2017, the Company filed its emergency rate application requesting the implementation of an emergency surcharge to cover the costs of repairing leaks in its only water storage tank. According to the Company, the surcharge is necessary to ensure the continued safe and adequate water service to its 216 customers.

On March 29, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued scheduling a procedural conference to commence on April 6, 2017, to discuss the scheduling of a hearing and other procedural matters.

On April 6, 2017, the procedural conference was convened, as scheduled, with Staff appearing through counsel, and the Company appearing through its president, Mr. Roger Wagner. At that time, Mr. Wagner informed the Commission that repairing the storage tank may no longer be a viable option given the age and condition of the tank. As a result, Mr. Wagner requested additional time to explore other options and file an amended emergency rate application.

Later on April 6, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued scheduling a procedural conference to commence to May 5, 2017, to discuss the status of the Company’s application and other procedural matters.

1 On May 5, 2017, the procedural conference was convened, as scheduled, with Staff appearing
2 through counsel, and the Company appearing through Mr. Wagner. At that time, the parties informed
3 the Commission that additional time was needed in order to evaluate the most appropriate course of
4 action for the Company to replace its aging storage tank.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** for the purpose of discussing
6 the further processing of this matter shall commence on **June 8, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon
7 thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona
8 85007.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall refer to the **Procedural**
10 **Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **March 29, 2016**, for additional
11 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to
12 Email Service is also available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) through the "Email
13 Service Consent" link.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules
15 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
17 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
18 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
20 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
21 hearing.


