14	Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona				
15	Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:				
16	FINDINGS OF FACT				
17	1. On March 29, 2017, Crown Correctional Telephone, Inc. ("CCTI") filed with th				
18	Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide				
19	customer owned pay telephone ("COPT") services. The proposed rates, charges, terms, and conditions				
20	for COPT service are contained in CCTI's proposed Generic COPT Tariff.				
21	2. On May 12, 2017, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Memorandum				
22	recommending approval of CCTI's application and its proposed Generic COPT Tariff.				
23	3. In its application, CCTI submitted a copy of the customer information placard that wil				
24	be affixed to all of CCTI's payphones. Staff has reviewed CCTI's placard and concluded that it meet				
25	the requirements of the Commission's Generic COPT Tariff.				
26	4. The Consumer Services Section of the Commission's Utilities Division reports r				
27	complaints or inquiries filed against CCTI in Arizona from January 1, 2014, through April 10, 201

1 The Consumer Services Section also reports that CCTI is in good standing with the Commission's 2 Corporations Division. 3 5. Staff recommends approval of CCTI's application, concluding that certain benefits in the form of increased pay telephone availability will accrue to the public and that the issuance of a 4 5 CC&N is in the public interest. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT 6 6. 7 providers are public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission. In Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992), the Commission adopted Arizona 8 7. 9 Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-901 through R14-2-909 to regulate COPT providers. Staff's recommendations are reasonable and should be adopted. 10 8. 11 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CCTI is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona 12 1. 13 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282. The Commission has jurisdiction over CCTI and the subject matter of the application. 2. 14 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT 15 **-**3. 16 CC&Ns without a hearing. CCTI's application to provide COPT services in Arizona is in the public interest. 17 4. 18 5. Staff's recommendation for approval of CCTI's application to obtain a CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona is reasonable and should be adopted. 19 20 . . . 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28
