9	BY THE COMMISSION:

11	On March 6, 2017, Kim R. Gaines ("Complainant") filed with the Arizona Corporation
12	Commission ("Commission") a Formal Complaint against Citizens Utilities Rural Company, Inc. dba
13	Frontier Citizens Utilities Rural Company ("Frontier Citizens" or "Company"), alleging that the
14	Company had on numerous occasions failed to provide adequate telecommunications services to
15	Complainant's home.
16	On March 14, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued regarding consent to email service.
17	On April 13, 2017, Frontier Citizens filed a Response to the Formal Complaint and a request
18	for dismissal of the Complaint.
19	On April 25, 2017, by Procedural Order, a procedural conference was set for May 18, 2017, at
20	10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.
21	On May 2, 2017, Complainant filed a Request to appear telephonically for the procedural
22	conference scheduled for May 18, 2017.
23	On May 3, 2017, the Hearing Division filed a Memorandum for the purpose of mailing/emailing
24	Complainant's Request to all parties on the service list.
25	Also on May 3, 2017, by Procedural Order, Complainant's Request to appear by telephone was
26	granted.
27	On May 15, 2017, Frontier Citizens filed a Request to appear telephonically for the procedural
28	conference scheduled for May 18, 2017.

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On May 18, 2017, procedural conference was held as scheduled. Complainant appeared
 telephonically on his own behalf. Frontier Citizens did not appear. At the procedural conference,
 Complainant was granted time to file, by June 30, 2017, a reply to Frontier Citizen's request for
 dismissal of the Complaint.

Therefore, the response deadline for the response to the request for dismissal of the Complaint
should be memorialized. Further, it is unclear whether counsel for Frontier Citizens is in compliance
with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice
of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kim R. Gaines may file by June 30, 2017, a reply to
10 Citizens Utilities Rural Company, Inc. dba Frontier Citizens Utilities Rural Company request for
11 dismissal of the Complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Citizens Utilities Rural Company, Inc. dba Frontier
 Citizens Utilities Rural Company shall demonstrate, by making a filing in this docket by June
 30, 2017, its compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243
 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall refer to the Procedural
 Order Regarding Consent to Email Service issued in this matter on March 14, 2017, for additional
 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to
 Email Service is also available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) by clicking on "Email
 Service Consent."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at all hearings, procedural conferences, Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for

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discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
 Law Judge or Commission.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
4 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
5 hearing.
