PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Directing the Administrative Closure
of the Docket)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 22, 2017, Global Water-Santa Cruz Water Company, LLC and Global Water-Palo Verde Utilities Company, LLC (collectively, “Global”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for a waiver under Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-806 for a waiver related to the merger between Eagletail Water Company, L.C. and Water Utility of Eagletail, LLC (collectively, “Eagletail”).

On March 31, 2017, a Procedural Order was issued regarding consent to email service.

On April 17, 2017, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Memorandum stating that under A.A.C. R14-2-806(A), the Commission may waive compliance with any provision of this Article upon finding that such a waiver is in the public interest. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-806(C), if “the Commission fails to approve, disapprove, or suspend for further consideration an application for waiver within 30 days following filing of a verified application for waiver, the waiver shall be effective on the 31st day following filing of the application.” Staff concluded that a waiver of A.A.C. R14-2- 806 in this case would be in the public interest, found no reason to reject the waiver, and recommended approval of the waiver.


On April 27, 2017, Commissioner Tobin filed a request that the Application for Waiver not be placed on the May Open Meeting agenda and be deemed approved by the operation of law.

1 On May 25, 2017 Global and Eagletail filed a Motion for Administrative Closure stating that
2 the waiver requested in the Application had taken effect pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-806(C) and that
3 the merger transaction has closed.

4 Global's request for administrative closure of the docket is reasonable and should be
5 approved.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket Nos. W-03936A-17-0080, W-20446A-17-0080,
7 and SW-20445A-17-0080 are hereby administratively closed.


