 On February 24, 2017, YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax" or "Applicant") submitted an Application requesting elimination of the bond or letter of credit requirement contained in Decision No. 69644.

Background

In Decision No. 69644, dated June 6, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") ordered YMax to procure either a performance bond or an irrevocable sight draft letter of credit ("ISDLOC") equal to \$110,000, file proof of such with Docket Control, and deliver the original to the Commission's Business Office. YMax was also ordered to keep the performance bond on file in effect until further order of the Commission. On August 6, 2007, YMax filed proof that it had obtained a performance bond in the amount of \$110,000 and had delivered the original to the Commission's Business Office.

Staff has confirmed the Utilities Division is in possession of the following:

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

 YMax Communications Corp. is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona Constitution.

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2. The Commission has jurisdiction over YMax Communications Corp. and the subject matter in this filing.

The Commission, having reviewed the filing and Staff's Memorandum dated May 25,
2017, concludes that it is in the public interest to approve YMax Communications Corp.'s Application as proposed and discussed herein.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application of YMax Communications Corp. to terminate the performance bond requirements contained in Decision No. 69644 be and hereby is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that YMax Communications Corp. may cancel, rescind, discontinue and be released from any performance bond, irrevocable sight draft letter of credit or other instrument obtained in compliance with the \$110,000 performance bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit requirements set by Decision No. 69644.
