17 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona  
18 Corporation Commission (“Commission”) finds, concludes, and orders that:

19 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 20 1. Arizona Public Service Company (“APS” or “Company”) is certificated to provide  
21 electric service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.
- 22 2. Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-2405, APS is required to  
23 submit an Energy Efficiency Implementation Plan that includes its proposed Demand Side  
24 Management Implementation Plan (“DSM Plan”) for Commission review and approval.
- 25 3. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-2405(A), APS’ 2018 DSM Plan is due June 1, 2017.
- 26 4. On May 11, 2017, APS filed a Request for an Extension of Time to file its 2018 DSM  
27 Plan. APS requests that the deadline for its 2018 DSM Plan be extended to September 1, 2017.
- 28 5. APS states that the utility industry in Arizona is undergoing a transformation, and that  
APS continues, pursuant to Decision No. 75679 (August 5, 2016), to work on appropriate and cost-  
effective strategies to utilize DSM programs to address evolving system conditions, including demand  
management and peak reduction.

1           6.       On May 30, 2017, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Memorandum  
2 indicating that it does not object to the requested extension of time.

3                                       **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4           1.       APS is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV, Section  
5 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

6           2.       APS is an “electric utility” and an “affected utility” pursuant to A.A.C. 14-2-2401.

7           3.       The Commission has jurisdiction over APS and the subject matter of its request.

8           4.       It is in the public interest to grant a waiver of the Company’s obligation to file its 2018  
9 DSM Plan on June 1, 2017, in order to allow APS to file its 2018 DSM Plan by September 1, 2017.

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**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the requirement that Arizona Public Service Company file its 2018 DSM Plan by June 1, 2017 pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-2405(A), is waived to allow Arizona Public Service Company until September 1, 2017, to file its 2018 DSM Plan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
