On February 28, 2017, Liberty Utilities (Litchfield Park Water & Sewer) Corp. ("Liberty Litchfield Park") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"), in Docket No. SW-01428A-17-0058, an application requesting that the Commission establish the fair value of its plant and property used for the provision of public wastewater utility service for Liberty Litchfield Park customers and, based on such finding, approve permanent rates and charges for utility service designed to produce a fair return thereon. On March 17, 2017, Liberty Litchfield Park filed with the Commission, in Docket No. SW-01428A-17-0078, an application requesting authority from the Commission to issue evidence of indebtedness for Liberty Litchfield Park in a total amount not to exceed \$30,000,000.

Liberty Litchfield Park requests authorization to increase its wastewater rates to generate total revenues of \$15,130,755. This would constitute an increase in revenues by \$3,496,801, or 30.06 percent over test year revenues of \$11,633,954.
