On February 28, 2017, Rose Valley Water Company ("Rose Valley" or "Company")

The Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a determination of the fair value of its utility plant and property, and for increases in its

determination of the fair value of its utility plant and property, and for increases in its rates and charges for water service.

The Company is requesting rates to produce total operating revenue of \$1,388,655, an increase of \$425,000, or 44.10 percent, over adjusted test year revenue of \$963,655. The Company's proposed rates would increase the monthly water bill for a 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter residential customer with median usage of 8,507 gallons from \$17.64 to \$27.85, an increase of \$9.91, or 56.18 percent. The actual percentage rate increase for individual customers that would result from the application will vary depending upon the type and quantity of service provided. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") is in the process of reviewing and analyzing the application. Neither Staff nor any intervenor has yet made any recommendation regarding Rose Valley, Staff, or any intervenor(s). The Commission will determine the appropriate ratemaking treatment of the revenues and expenses related to Rose Valley's application based on the evidence presented in this proceeding.

About Intervention

Intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other parties' witnesses. Intervention is not required if you want to appear at the hearing and provide public comment on the application, or if you want to file written comments in the record of the case.

To request intervention, you must file an original and 13 hard copies of a written request to intervene with Docket Control, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, no later than July 7, 2017.
