**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On December 29, 2016, the Securities Division (“Division”) of the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (“Notice”) against Clear Energy Group, LLC (“CEG”) and Paul W. Ramirez (collectively “Respondents”) in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act (“Act”) in connection with offer and sale of securities in the form of notes and fractional undivided interests in oil and mineral rights.

On June 28, 2017, the Division filed an Application to Amend (“Application”) the Notice. The Division states that it wishes to add additional allegations to the Notice concerning new information related to the initial filing. The Division further states that the Respondents have not yet been served and that their rights will not be prejudiced if the Division’s Application is approved.

Accordingly, the Division’s Application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application to Amend the Notice filed by the Division is hereby granted.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission’s Decision

3 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
4 hearing.
