**RE: EMERGENCY RATE CASE APPLICATION** DOCKET NO. W-20940A-17-0124

Carter Water Company is formally requesting an emergency rate surcharge to be effective immediately. The emergency surcharge request is prudent to maintaining adequate water service to its customers.

Nelson Drilling has installed the equipment and made the necessary repairs to keep water service for Carter Water Company. The system failed to produce water for customers on April 11, 2017. Nelson Drilling was called to evaluate the system on that date. It was found that the pump and motor on the well needed to be replaced. Those repairs were made on April 12, 2017. The cost of the repairs made we \$2,881.80. (Please see enclosed-Insert "A"). It was noted at that time that the pneumatic tank was also in need of work, it had a bolt screwed into the bottom of the tank to repair a previous water leak. We discussed the need and with the current expense and repairs being made, and the lack of finances we would plan for future repairs.

It was noted on April 24th that the pneumatic tank had started to leak at the side opening due to rust. Nelson Drilling was called to evaluate the tank, and their recommendation was to not repair the tank due to the condition of the tank and the expense of repairing it. Their suggestion was to replace the pneumatic tank with two pressure tanks. Nelson Drilling installed the two pressure tanks on April 27, 2017. The cost of the installation of the pressure tanks was \$2,788.43 (Please see enclosed - Insert "B"). This repair seemed to solve the problems with the system.

On June 12, 2017, we were again notified by customers that the water pressure was low. Nelson Drilling was called again to evaluate the system. On June 14th, it was found that the water flow was being obstructed by the meter. The well casing is thought to be collapsing which caused debris to be pumped and clog the meter. We have a one-inch meter on a two-inch water line coming from the well. At that time, the meter was removed allowing water to flow. Currently there is a need to provide a 2inch meter on the well. The cost of the new meter would be \$729.42. (Please see enclosed -Insert C)

On June 16<sup>th,</sup> the storage tank overflowed. Adjustments were made to the floats in the storage tank but on June 17th the storage tank failed to fill. Nelson Drilling was called and the storage tank floats were replaced. The cost of this repair was \$549.03 (Please see enclosed -Insert D).

Due to the insolvency of Carter Water Company the repairs have come as an expense to the owner, Gonzalez Utility Services. The repairs to Carter Water Company were necessary to continue to provide water to its customers. The total expense of the repairs is \$6938.68. Carter Water Company made a payment of \$1300.00 towards the balance leaving the current balance of \$5638.68. Carter Water Company has no money to pay the remaining balance of the repairs. Therefore, the balance of \$5638.68 divided by (12) months is \$469.89. To determine the requested monthly surcharge amount, the \$469.89 should be divided among the 11 customers that receive unlimited amounts of water from Carter Water Company. This amount would be \$42.72 for the proposed surcharge. The proposed dollar amount covers only the cost of the repairs made to continue to provide water to its customers.

It is suggested that the emergency surcharge deemed adequate and fair would be \$42.72/MONTH/CUSTOMER. It is also suggested that this amount be added as part of their monthly service billing as a surcharge item. Customers currently are billed \$20.00 for unlimited amounts of water per month.

It would be the intent of Carter Water Company to collect this surcharge from all customers, currently we have 2 customers who pay for water but don't live at their residence. I believe they will cancel services if the surcharge is approved, and will reconnect with the system later.

It would be the intent of the surcharge to repay the loan amount from its owner, Gonzalez Utility Services. The surcharge monies would be placed in a separate account, and a monthly loan amount would be disbursed to Gonzalez Utility Services.

We ask that you please understand the need for our request and that you review or application with the same respect.

# PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION OF CARTER WATER COMPANY FOR AN EMERGENCY RATE INCREASE (DOCKET NO. W-20940A-17-0124)

On July 21, 2017 Carter Water Company ("Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an emergency rate increase. The Company claims that it is entitled to emergency rate relief because of prudent and necessary replacement of well motor, pump and meter, pressure tanks, and storage tank floats. The Company made the necessary repairs in the amount of \$6938.68 to alleviate the emergency condition. The Company is requesting authorization to recover \$5638.68 in emergency rates by implementing a monthly surcharge in the amount of \$42.72 per customer.

The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") is in the process of reviewing and analyzing the Application. Neither Staff nor any intervenor(s) has yet made any recommendation regarding the Company's request. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenor(s), and the Commission may approve the amount of the request, modify the amount higher or lower, or deny the request.

### How You Can View or Obtain a Copy of the Application

Copies of the Application are available from Carter Water Company, P. O. Box 86205, Phoenix, AZ 85080; at the Commission's Docket Control Center at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, during regular business hours; and on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function.

### **Arizona Corporation Commission Public Hearing Information**

The Commission will hold a full public hearing on this matter. The Commission's Hearing Division will schedule a procedural conference to occur within five business days of the filing of the Application in order to set a public hearing date and establish other procedural requirements.

The Company will provide notice of the hearing date by means of posting notice in a conspicuous location within the affected communities, emailing notice to customers, and/or posting on the Company's website (or by other appropriate means), to allow an opportunity for customers to attend the hearing and provide verbal public comment.

Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted at any time by mailing a letter referencing **Docket No. W-20940A-17-0124** to Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, or by submitting comments on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "Submit a Public Comment for a Utility" function. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section during regular business hours at 602-542-4251 or 1-800-222-7000.

### **About Intervention**

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested persons may intervene. An interested person may be granted intervention if the outcome of the case Page 4 will directly and substantially impact the person, and the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case. Intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other parties' witnesses. Intervention is not required if you want to appear at the hearing and provide public comment on the Application, or if you want to file written comments in the record of the case.

To request intervention, you must file an **original plus one hard copy** (if the application is for a Class A or B utility, an original plus 13 hard copies are required) of a written request to intervene with Docket Control, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, no later than July 17, 2017. You also must serve a copy of the request to intervene on each party of record on the same day that you file the request to intervene with the Commission. **Information about what intervention means, including an explanation of the rights and responsibilities of an intervenor, is available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "Intervention in Utility Cases" link.** The link also includes sample intervention requests.

If you choose to request intervention, your request must contain the following:

- 1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
- 2. A reference to Docket No. W-20940A-17-0124
- 3. A short statement explaining:
  - a. Your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.);
  - b. How you will be directly and substantially affected by the outcome of the case; and
  - c. Why your intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case;
- 4. A statement certifying that you have served a copy of the request to intervene on the Company or its attorney and to all parties of record in the case; and
- 5. If you are not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and you are not representing yourself as an individual, sufficient information and any appropriate documentation to demonstrate compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before July 28, 2017.

If you do not intervene in this proceeding, you may not receive any further notice of the proceedings in this docket. However, all documents filed in this docket are available online (usually within 24 hours after docketing) at the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the eDocket function. You may choose to subscribe to an RSS feed for this case using the e-Docket function.
