**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 23, 2007, North Mohave Valley Corporation ("NMVC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water service in Mohave County, Arizona.

On August 22, 2007, Staff filed a Letter of Insufficiency in this docket indicating that NMVC has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C").

On August 27, 2007, NMVC filed an amended legal description and on August 30, 2007, NMVC filed Proof of Publication.

On September 19, 2007, NMVC filed its Response to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On October 16, 2007, Staff filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket, indicating NMVC's application had met the requirements of the A.A.C.

On October 30, 2007, by Procedural Order, a hearing in this matter was set for December 13, 2007, and other procedural deadlines were set.

On November 1, 2007, Staff filed Motion to extend the deadline for filing its Staff Report from October 30, 2007, to December 17, 2007. Staff requests the additional time to ensure that the Staff Report will provide the Commission with the information and analysis it will need in order to evaluate the issues raised in this proceeding.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff's Motion to extend deadline is hereby granted and  
2 new dates will be established in a subsequent Procedural Order.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized  
4 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 31 and 38 of the Rules of  
6 the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
7 *hac vice*.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
9 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
10 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to  
11 appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter  
12 is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by  
13 the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
15 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
16 hearing.
