ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND RECONSIDERATION OF DECISION NO. 72026

1 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

2 On December 10, 2010, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued
3 Decision No. 72026 in this docket.

4 On December 29, 2010, Litchfield Park Service Company ("LPSCO" or "Company") timely
5 filed an Application for Rehearing of Decision No. 72026 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-253.

6 On January 14, 2011, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed a Request for
7 Reconsideration under A.R.S. § 40-252.

8 During its January 18, 2011, Staff Open Meeting, the Commission voted to grant LPSCO's
9 Application for Rehearing of Decision No. 72026, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-253, and to grant RUCO's
10 Request for Reconsideration of Decision No. 72026, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252. The Commission
11 directed the Hearing Division to issue a procedural order scheduling a procedural conference for the
12 purpose of setting a procedural schedule for the rehearing proceeding, to conduct a hearing on the
13 issues raised by the Company and RUCO, and to prepare a Recommended Order on Rehearing for
14 the Commission's consideration.

15 By Procedural Order issued January 19, 2011, a procedural conference was scheduled for
16 January 26, 2011.

17 At the January 26, 2011, procedural conference, the parties discussed proposed procedures for
18 conducting the rehearing/reconsideration of Decision No. 72026.

19 On February 16, 2011, Commissioner Newman filed a letter to the docket requesting that the
20 decision to grant rehearing/reconsideration during the January 18, 2011, Staff Open Meeting be
21 scheduled for an Open Meeting to reconsider whether rehearing/reconsideration should be granted.

22 The matter was discussed at the Commission's regular Open Meeting on March 1 and 2,
23 2011, during which the Commissioners passed a motion to rescind its prior vote to grant rehearing
24 and reconsideration of Decision No. 72026, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-253 and A.R.S. § 40-252,
25 respectively.

26 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Commission's vote at the January 18, 2011 Staff
27 Open Meeting, to grant LPSCO's Application for Rehearing of Decision No. 72026, pursuant to
28 A.R.S. § 40-253, and to grant RUCO's Request for Reconsideration of Decision No. 72026, pursuant


1 to A.R.S. § 40-252, is hereby rescinded and, accordingly, rehearing and reconsideration of Decision
2 No. 72026 are denied as of the effective date of this Order.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.






