**NOTIFICATION OF
INTERVENTION**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 2, 2012, Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP" filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for a rate increase.

On July 27, 2012, Southern Arizona Homebuilders Association ("SAHBA") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene. SAHBA is a member trade organization which includes home builders, developers and associate members, and represents building industry professionals. SAHBA members participate in, and are affected by, TEP's energy efficiency programs.

On July 30, 2012, Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold Inc. ("Freeport-McMoRan") and Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene. Freeport-McMoRan is an electric customer of the TEP and AECC is a coalition of energy consumers, most of whom are customers of TEP.

On August 2, 2012, The Kroger Co. ("Kroger"), a retail customer of TEP that operates numerous grocery stores and other facilities, filed a Petition to Intervene.

On August 3, 2012, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed an Application to Intervene. RUCO is statutorily authorized to represent residential ratepayers in matters before the Commission.

On August 9, 2012, EnerNOC, Inc. ("EnerNOC") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene.


1 EnerNOC provides energy management services to commercial, institutional and industrial customers
2 and has a contractual arrangement with TEP to provide energy efficiency services to TEP customers.

3 On August 10, 2012, Arizona Public Service Company7 (“APS”) filed a Motion to Intervene.
4 APS is a wholesale supplier of electricity to TEP as well as an occasional purchaser of electricity
5 from TEP, and co-owns certain generation and transmission facilities with TEP.

6 No party objected to these intervention requests, and each of the applicants has a direct
7 interest in TEP’s rate case proceeding.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the requests to intervene by SAHBA, Freeport-
9 McMoRan, AECC, RUCO, EnerNOC, Kroger, and APS are granted.

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
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
