**RUCO'S MOTION TO EXTEND FILING DATES
(EXPEDITED RULING REQUESTED)**


The RESIDENTIAL UTILITY CONSUMER OFFICE ("RUCO") hereby requests an extension to move back the filing dates for testimony in support/opposition to a Settlement Agreement from April 19, 2013 until April 26, 2013 and the responsive testimony from April 26, 2013 to May 3, 2013. RUCO's motion is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay and should not prejudice any party since the hearing in this matter is scheduled to start on May 13, 2013.

RUCO received a copy of the Settlement late yesterday and the scheduled date of filing was April 12, 2013. RUCO does not question the later filing date and understands it was filed in good faith. However, the current date scheduled for the initial testimony is this

1 Friday, April 19, and responsive testimony is April 26. RUCO does oppose the Settlement
2 and would like to extend the testimony due dates. RUCO is presently going over the filed
3 agreement and needs more time to file its testimony. RUCO is a party in the Far West
4 hearing which starts next Monday and the same witness who will be testifying in that
5 matter will be submitting testimony in this matter. With the hearing date scheduled for May
6 13, the parties will have 10 days to prepare for the hearing after RUCO files its responsive
7 testimony if approved – which should be more than adequate.

8 RUCO has been in touch with the Staff and the Company and will let them file their
9 own response if they feel it is necessary.
