RUCO'S MOTION TO INCORPORATE THE RECORD


18 The RESIDENTIAL UTILITY CONSUMER OFFICE ("RUCO") hereby moves to
 19 incorporate the record of the recent hearings in Docket No.W-01445A-11-0310 ("Eastern
 20 Group or Eastern Group Docket") into the current docket¹. The Settlement in the present case
 21 proposes the same SIB mechanism that is currently under consideration in the Eastern Group
 22 Docket. See Staff's Notice of Filing Settlement Agreement, paragraph 6.1. The recent
 23 hearings on the SIB, as well as the Company's proposed DSIC in the Eastern Group were
 24 lengthy and contentious. From RUCO's perspective, it would seem to be an inefficient use of

1 the Commission's resources and might add unnecessary rate case expense to recreate a
2 record which, for the most part, already exists. RUCO is not suggesting that any party be
3 limited in any manner to asking supplemental questions or raising other issues on this subject
4 as it pertains to this particular case. However, beyond that, it would be redundant to spend
5 several days on creating the same record which has already been established in the Eastern
6 Group Docket.

7 In the alternative the Commission could take judicial notice of the Eastern Group
8 Docket. RUCO believes incorporating the record is a better way to go as it leaves no
9 questions and may be easier administratively but would be satisfied with judicial notice
10 provided it is understood that the Eastern Group record is considered part of this record and
11 could be referenced as such.

12 RUCO has contacted the Company and Staff. Staff agrees. The Company agrees with
13 the judicial notice alternative.
