PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On February 28, 2013, Litchfield Park Service Company dba Liberty Utilities ("LPSCO" or "Company") filed the above-captioned rate applications with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").

On April 12, 2013, a Rate Case Procedural Order was issued, consolidating the dockets, scheduling the matter for hearing, setting procedural deadlines, and directing public notice of the applications and hearing.

Intervention has been granted to the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO").

On May 10, 2013, the Company filed a Request to Correct Notice ("Request"). Attached to the Request were Exhibits A and B. Exhibit A to the Request is a clean version of the corrected notice, and Exhibit B to the Request is a redlined version of the corrected notice showing the changes that the Company made to the form of notice ordered in the April 12, 2013 Rate Case Procedural Order. LPSCO asks that the corrected version of public notice shown in Exhibit A to the Request be

1 substituted and approved so that LPSCO may include it in its customers' June 2013 billing  
2 statements.

3 The Company's Request is reasonable and should be granted.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that LPSCO shall **mail** to each of its customers a copy of  
5 the notice appearing in Exhibit A to its May 10, 2013, Request to Correct Notice, as a bill insert, and  
6 shall cause a copy of such notice to be **published at least once in a newspaper** of general circulation  
7 in LPSCO's service territory, with mailing and publication to be completed no later than **June 28,**  
8 **2013.**

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other requirements and deadlines set forth in the April  
10 12, 2013, Rate Case Procedural Order remain in effect.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
12 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
14 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
15 hearing.
